

# Adopting an educational development perspective



Educational development is the iterative process of developing the quality and societal relevance of higher education (Gregersen-Hermans and Lauridsen, 2021)

- A series of incremental steps
- Steps are repeated and data is gathered
- Steps are improved and developed over time



# The IoC process in 5 steps

(Leask, 2015)

Review and reflect: To what extent is our curriculum internationalised?


Imagine: What other ways of thinking and doing are possible?

Revise and plan: Given the possibilities for IoC, what changes do we want to make to our programmes?


Act: How will we know if we have achieved our IoC goals?

Evaluate: To what extent have we reached our internationalisation goals?





The process of incorporating areas of educational competence into the content and delivery of the curriculum, its learning outcomes and teaching and learning arrangements, as well as the support services of a programme of study, with a view to promoting quality learning (adapted from Leask, 2015).




Periodic, critical review of the curriculum:

- Impact and outcomes of teaching and assessment practices on student learning
- Review of content and pedagogy
- Recognition of past and current successes (and making them visible)
- Development of new possibilities
- Student and administrative staff are our partners
